



### THE WANDERERS (Queensland) CLUB

The Club was formed in Queensland in 1933 by the then Governor of Queensland, Sir Leslie Wilson, to encourage young people to play and enjoy the game of Cricket. In this era, the Club plays more than 20 mid-week matches each Summer, mostly against schools in the State's south-east, and undertakes an annual 12-day playing and coaching tour of country centres. Tours in this decade have taken the Wanderers as far to our north-west as Hughenden, as far to our central-west as Winton, and as far to the south-west as Quilpie, and over the border to Bourke. The Club relies upon its own fund-raising resources and sponsors to finance its growing activities.



### THE LORD'S TAVERNERS (Queensland)

The Club was conceived in 1949 by a group of actors and members of allied professions who habitually watched Cricket from the Tavern at Lord's Cricket Ground in London. The Club spread to Australia in 1982 and became an autonomous body with branches in all States and Territories. The primary aim of the Taverners, as a benevolent body, is to propagate the game of Cricket at all levels, with an emphasis on the underprivileged and disadvantaged. The Club promotes the enjoyment of companionship which Cricket offers and, in a brief period, has made a significant impact in the game and with its supporters in Queensland.
